#### **COLD-WEATHER INFORMATION**



Recesses will be outdoors unless outdoor temperatures fall below -20°C (including windchill) then, in accordance with Board policy & guidelines, MDL students will have indoor recess. Please ensure that your child(ren) have appropriate clothing to enjoy our Canadian winter! Students should come to school with outdoor footwear/boots, hats, mittens/gloves and proper outerwear, such as a winter

jacket. We also encourage students to bring an extra pair of socks, pants and mittens/gloves, which can be kept in their or cubby, in case they get wet during outdoor recess. **Please remember to label your child(ren)'s belongings** so if they are misplaced, they can be returned to their rightful owner! Also, a reminder that students who are not well enough to play outdoors during nutritional breaks should remain at home

#### ALLERGY ALERT

Just a reminder that we are a **peanut/tree nut safe** school. We have students and staff with severe, life-threatening allergies to **peanuts and tree nuts**. Also, please note that



the use of peanut butter substitutes (e.g., Wow Butter) is <u>not permitted</u> as it is difficult for staff to monitor and may cause anxiety for those with a life-threatening allergy. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in helping to keep ALL of our kids safe!

#### **VOLUNTEERING**

If you are wishing to volunteer in the school, for a class trip, etc., please ensure that you have an up-to-date police check and/or declaration. If you are unsure, please contact the office. We also kindly ask that, police checks are submitted to the office **at least 3 days prior** to an event (i.e., class trip) taking place. This ensures adequate time for it to be processed.

### KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR SEPTEMBER 2024

New Junior and Senior Kindergarten registrations for the 2024 – 2025 school year will start during the month of January. If you know of any families with Kindergarten-aged children who will be attending Madonna Della Libera next year, please let them know to register! For Junior Kindergarten, children must be 4 years old by December 31, 2024 and for students registering in Senior Kindergarten, they must be 5 years old by December 31, 2024.

# WHEN CAN I REGISTER MY CHILD?

**Registration for Kindergarten will open on January 8th, 2024** for BHNCDSB elementary schools. Early registration greatly assists the school with planning and organizing for the coming school year. **For our French Immersion program, registration MUST take place before February 23, 2024** due to limits on class sizes. Any French Immersion registrations that occur after February 23 will be placed on a waitlist and acceptance is not guaranteed after this date.

# HOW DO WE REGISTER?

The Board's Kindergarten registration process is online via <u>www.catholiceducation.ca</u>. In order to complete the online registration there are some documents that you will need to have ready to upload. We recommend either scanning or taking an image/photo of the documents in advance of beginning the registration process.

# What documents do I need?

- Birth certificate or proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residence status (citizenship documentation, permanent resident card or record of landing).
- Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate or, if your child is not baptized, the Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate of the parent(s) or guardian(s) must be provided.
- Proof of home address (a rental/lease agreement, utility bill, proof of purchase, etc.).

# Where do I go to register?

- Prepare electronic copies of the required documents and visit <u>www.catholiceducation.ca</u> to register.

#### A Message Provide by the Brant County Health Unit (www.bchu.org)

In Ontario, as per the Immunization of School Pupils Act, 1990 (ISPA), all students between the age of 4-17 must provide proof of routine childhood immunization with Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Polio, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Meningitis, and Varicella (for children born in 2010 and after), or have a valid exemption, in order to attend school. This information is used to help protect students and the public in case there is a vaccine preventable disease outbreak in our community. The Health Unit is mandated to enforce ISPA and assess the immunization status of children in accordance with the Immunization for Children in Schools and Licensed Child Care Settings Protocol, 2018.

Each year, the Brant County Health Unit assesses the immunization records of students around the age of 7 and the age of 17 to ensure students are compliant with immunization requirements. Students who fail to provide proof of immunization, or a valid exemption, may be suspended from school for up to 20 school days.

This year (2023-2024 school year) the focused cohorts are the following birth years: 2006, 2007, 2014, 2015, and 2016. The suspension period for elementary students will begin in March 2024.


