#### **Outdoor Supervision**

A reminder that there is no supervision outside before 8:25 AM or after 3:00 PM, with the exception of bus supervision.

Kindergarten will go directly into their play area in the morning, under the supervision of staff.

All visitors are also reminded to please sign in at the office upon entering the school.

#### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

Madonna Della Libera is designated **ZONE 4.**This means if bus transportation is cancelled in Zone 4, then the school is closed for **ALL** students. There is one exception – when transportation is cancelled due to extreme cold weather



which makes the operation of busses difficult and the wait times for students for the bus problematic. In this situation, schools and school facilities would remain open to staff and students.

#### **REPORT CARDS**



First term report cards will be sent home with your child(ren) on **Monday**, **February 5**, **2024**. Please take some time to review the report card with your child(ren) and comment on the third page of the report. This is a great opportunity for your child to set some goals for the remainder of the school year! Please note that

interviews were held with the progress reports in November, however, you may request a meeting with your child(ren)'s teacher(s) at any time.

#### **COLD-WEATHER INFORMATION**

Recesses will be outdoors unless outdoor temperatures fall below -20°C (including windchill) then, in accordance with Board policy & guidelines, OLOP students will have indoor recess. Please ensure that your child(ren) have appropriate clothing to enjoy our Canadian winter! Students should come to school with boots, hats, mittens/gloves and proper outerwear, such



as snowpants and a winter jacket. We also encourage parents to send an extra pair of socks, pants and mittens/gloves, which can be kept in your child(ren)'s backpack or cubby, in case they get wet during outdoor recess. Please remember to label your child(ren)'s belongings so if they are misplaced, they can be returned to their rightful owner! Also, a reminder that students who are not well enough to play outdoors during nutritional breaks should remain at home until they feel well enough to participate in a full school day.

#### VALENTINE'S DAY CELEBRATIONS— TUESDAY, FEB.13th

This year, Ash Wednesday falls on February 14th. This day also marks the beginning of the penitential season of Lent. To keep with the solemnity of this day, and



under direction from the Board and the Diocese, we will be holding our Valentine's celebrations on **Tuesday**, **February 13**<sup>th</sup>. On this day, students will still be encouraged to share cards of friendship and affection and classes will still celebrate Valentine's Day in their special way. Please remember that any snacks brought in on this day MUST be **peanut/tree nut free** as indicated on the label (no homemade items are permitted) and, as always, we encourage healthy treats!

St. Valentine inspires us to reflect on and celebrate love. Ash Wednesday reminds us that it is the love of God that saves us. May this year, where these two important days coincide, bring us to an even deeper appreciation of the words of Saint Paul:

#### **CHRISTMAS TOYS**

With Christmas having passed, many students received some very special gifts from Santa and are excited to play with them and show them off. Please be reminded that students are strongly discouraged from bringing personal items (i.e., toys, "stuffies", electronics, etc.) to school, unless directed by a teacher to do so (i.e., for "show and share", "fun Friday", etc.). These items can be a distraction to student learning as well as end up lost or damaged. If your child (ren) chooses to bring toys to school, we assume no responsibility for these items.

#### **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION for 2024-2025**

New Kindergarten registrations for the 2024 – 2025 school year begin this month! If you know of any other families with Kindergarten-aged children who will be attending Madonna Della Libera next year, please let them know to register as soon as possible! For Junior Kindergarten, children must be 4 years old by December 31, 2024 and for students registering in Senior Kindergarten, they must be 5 years old by December 31, 2024.

#### WHEN CAN I REGISTER MY CHILD?

Registration for Kindergarten takes place from January 8th through February 23rd. Registration during this timeframe greatly assists the school with planning and organizing for the coming school year. For our French **Immersion** program, registration MUST take place before February 23, 2024 due to limits on class sizes. Any French Immersion registrations that occur after February 23 will be placed on a waitlist and acceptance is not guaranteed after this date.



#### **HOW DO WE REGISTER?**

The Board's Kindergarten registration process is online via <u>www.catholiceducation.ca</u>. In order to complete the online registration there are some documents that you will need to have ready to upload. We recommend either scanning or taking an image/photo of the documents in advance of beginning the registration process.

#### What documents do I need?

- Birth certificate or proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residence status (citizenship documentation, permanent resident card or record of landing).
- Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate or, if your child is not baptized, the Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate of the parent(s) or guardian(s).
- Proof of home address (e.g., a rental/lease agreement, utility bill, proof of purchase, etc.).

#### Where do I go to register?

- Prepare electronic copies of the required documents and visit <u>www.catholiceducation.ca</u> to register.

#### A Message Provide by the Brant County Health Unit (www.bchu.org)

In Ontario, as per the <u>Immunization of School Pupils Act, 1990 (ISPA)</u>, all students between the age of 4-17 must provide proof of routine childhood immunization with Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Polio, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Meningitis, and Varicella (for children born in 2010 and after), or have a valid exemption, in order to attend school. This information is used to help protect students and the public in case there is a vaccine preventable disease outbreak in our community. The Health Unit is mandated to enforce ISPA and assess the immunization status of children in accordance with the <u>Immunization for Children in Schools and Licensed Child Care Settings Protocol</u>, 2018.

Each year, the Brant County Health Unit assesses the immunization records of students around the age of 7 and the age of 17 to ensure students are compliant with immunization requirements. Students who fail to provide proof of immunization, or a valid exemption, may be suspended from school for up to 20 school days.

This year (2023-2024 school year) the focused cohorts are the following birth years: 2006, 2007, 2014, 2015, and 2016. The suspension period for elementary students will begin in March 2024.
